I felt at ease immediately. I noticed that everyone seemed relaxed

I was welcomed and comfortable

I really enjoyed hearing everyone's thoughts and perspectives on the idea of home

I felt listened to and my ideas appreciated

AFTER THE SESSION ..

Before I didn't believe social prescribing could be that useful to people. However, my original thoughts were wrong. When people discussed why they came to the sessions it really showed how important it was to them and how much it has helped them



I can completely recognise how that would benefit someone and promote inclusion. I would really recommend it to people who were lonely but also who enjoyed that sort of creative friendly inclusion

I felt calm and relaxed

I felt like it would be very beneficial for people with social anxiety as if you go regularly it's nice to make friends and socialise

I like the house to be dark
I know where everything is
And surroundings
And I never lock the door.
I am the keeper of my soud
Nothing worth having
Can be taken away. (from me)
